Program: The Mothercraft Parent-Infant Program provides home-based and center-based early intervention services for infants and young children who face biological and psychosocial risks to their development due to parental substance use and related problems. The Parent-Infant Program provides services through Breaking the Cycle, serving parents and children who are affected by substance abuse. The program uses an ecological model to meet the needs of both parent and child, with the ultimate goal of optimizing the child’s healthy development and the parent-child relationship.

Position Description: The successful candidate will conduct observations, interviews and assessments through home visits with parents and children who have been referred to the program. She/he will develop individual service plans and deliver attachment-based early intervention services based on these plans. She/he will maintain all required documentation and assist with provision of services to all facets of the program as required.

Qualifications: The successful candidate will possess Bachelor’s degree in psychology, social work, psychology, early childhood education, and or related field, with a strong background in infancy, early child development, and family systems. The candidate must be a member in good standing with a College recognized by the Psychotherapy Act, 2007. She/he will have a minimum of 1-year experience in working with “hard-to-reach”, multi-risk families, and will have a comfort level in working with substance-involved families. The ability to work in a trans-disciplinary partnership model, and as a member of a team, is essential. Experience in working in home-based and centre-based models is important. A strong working knowledge of the Child & Family Services Act, together with knowledge of community resources is essential. Excellent written and verbal communication skills are required. A car and valid driver’s license is required. French is an asset.
