**PROGRAM:** The Early Intervention (EI) Department offers early intervention/children’s mental health programs designed to reduce risk and to enhance the development for substance-exposed children (prenatal - 6 years) by providing services which address maternal addiction problems and related issues and the mother-child relationship through community based cross-systemic partnership. The EI department conducts evaluation and research activities focussed on issues relevant to the services in the area of early intervention. The programs available are, but not limited to: Breaking the Cycle, Parent-Infant Program, BTC Pregnancy Outreach Program.

**POSITION DESCRIPTION:** Reporting to Manager, Early Intervention Program, the Pregnancy Outreach Worker works in accordance with the mission and philosophy of Breaking the Cycle. Duties and responsibilities include the delivery of case management services to support pregnant women struggling with alcohol and/or other substances to access required services (prenatal health care, addiction treatment, housing, and others), to promote attachment to the pregnancy, and to prepare for parenting. Services are delivered through a street outreach approach. The Pregnancy Outreach Worker will maintain all required documentation and assist in the maintenance of collaborative relationships with service providers.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** The successful candidate will possess a community college or university education in social work, psychology, social sciences, addictions, nursing or other relevant discipline. The incumbent must have a minimum of three years of experience. The incumbent should also possess effective written communication skills including the ability to prepare clinical and other reports in compliance with standards of the Centre/Program; Effective and positive collaboration with multidisciplinary teams and service providers to facilitate programs or treatment goals; Demonstrated ability to understand and maintain client/worker boundaries; Ability to use supervision; Evidence of cultural awareness and sensitivity; Evidence of effective self-care strategies; Time management skills; Capacity to work independently and as a member of a multi-disciplinary team is essential; Strong working knowledge of the Child and Family Service Act.
