



ENHANCED LANGUAGE TRAINING: EARLY DEVELOPMENT

New full time program starting November 26, 2018!

Mothercraft College of Early Childhood Education offers the Enhanced Language Training (ELT) program for Early Development with funding from Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC). This program is designed to help you improve your English skills if you want to work in the community with young children or if you want to further your studies about young children.

The **Mothercraft ELT Program for Early Development** has small classroom sizes and individualized support. During the program, you will practice your English communication skills in reading, writing, listening, and speaking - specifically in the field of early learning and care. You will become more comfortable with the language used in the early development field in Canada and will also improve your employment readiness skills.

In addition to classes, there is a 4-week placement with young children so you can get Canadian workplace experience. You will practice interacting with young children and families in early learning centres and programs and will become more familiar with Canadian culture when working with diverse young children and families. Free TTC tickets may also be available to you (if you qualify).

The next program starts on November 26th, 2018 and ends on March 11th, 2019 and includes:

- Classes at Mothercraft College of Early Childhood Education (646 St. Clair Ave West)
- Monday to Friday, 9 am – 4 pm, from November 26th to February 5th
- 4 week work placement from February 11th – March 11th, 2019 for participants to gain valuable Canadian experience.
- **Prior to placement**, participants must provide the following to Mothercraft:
 - Medical Certificate completed by physician
 - Clear Police Reference Check
 - Standard First Aid and Infant Child CPR C training

You are eligible for this program if:

- you have international training related to work with young children
- you have international training in another field but want to work with young children in Canada
- you are a protected person, a convention refugee, or a permanent resident
- you have CLB 6 minimum (higher preferred)

This is a CERTIFICATE level program. Participants will receive an Enhanced Language Training: Early Development certificate upon successful completion.
